

Wine List Reds

Dante Cabernet Sauvignon ♦ California \$6/18

Rich and fleshy with wonderful cherry and smoky sage fruit upfront. Medium tannins with earthy mineral, dried berry and currant fruit that's full-bodied in the finish

Angeline Pinot Noir ♦ California \$7.50/24

Offers a nice balance of earthy, loamy and herbal notes, with fresh, crisp raspberry and strawberry flavors

Altos Las Hormigas Malbec ♦ Argentina \$7.50/24

A delicate bouquet of redcurrant, minty blackberry leaves and tenuous smokey notes. Aromas of passion fruit, accompanied by gentle white pepper follow. The palate is silky with a very delicate tannins, along with mango and plum notes.

McCay Zinfandel ♦ California \$26

Reminiscent of a late harvested fruit smoothie made with blackberry, sweet Oregon cherry, hazelnut and a hint of figs. The big berry swirl flavor continues all the way to the long lingering finish.

Liberty School Cabernet Sauvignon ♦ California \$24

Offers up-front aromas of ripe red fruit, followed by similar vibrant and rich berry flavors. Silky but firm tannins lend excellent structure, while maintaining a soft approachability

Bishops Peak Cabernet Sauvignon ♦ California \$32

The wine has a rich texture with flavors of bright plum and juicy raspberry, and finishes with smooth soft tannins

Milbrandt Traditions Merlot ♦ Washington \$25

Classic aromas of ripe dark red fruit, blackberry and hints of vanilla

Belle Glos Meiomi Pinot Noir ♦ California \$30

This wine is crafted, lush, balanced and luxurious. Three of the California's most sought after coastal growing regions brilliantly meld together in this deeply flavored, stylish and truly balanced Pinot Noir

St Hallett Faith Shiraz ♦ Australia \$8/\$25

A complex nose with notes of cherry, raspberry and plum, with a second layer of licorice and black pepper

Jeff Runquist 1448 Red ♦ California \$30

Big, bold flavors of black and red fruits layered with oak toast, coffee, earthy spices, and minerals. Together with the length of the taste on the palate and rich tannins this wine is a delight to sip

Robert Biale Black Chicken Zinfandel ♦ California \$50

A geyser of black and red fruit, coffee, spice and pencil lead notes. Ripe, round and utterly delicious

Wine List Whites & Sparklers

La Fiera Pinot Grigio ♦ Italy \$6/18

A fresh and crisp wine, both floral and fruity; it expresses ripe peach and apple flavors with a subtle mineral finish

Hess Select Chardonnay ♦ California \$7/22

Aromas of pear and citrus, highlighting lemon and lime, are followed on the palate with pineapple and tropical fruit flavors. Medium bodied and refreshing

Ponga Sauvignon Blanc ♦ New Zealand \$6/18

The palate displays white peach and grapefruit characters, accented with chalky mineral tones

Dr Loosen "Dr L" Riesling ♦ Germany \$7/22

Citrus blossom, lime and crushed stone aromas are followed by apple and citrus flavors in this just-slightly-sweet wine

Honig Sauvignon Blanc ♦ California \$26

Grapefruit, melon rind, and green apple linger in the nose, but the mouthfeel is round and possesses more tropical flavors

Hendry Unoaked Chardonnay ♦ California \$33

Very clean and beautifully focused in its citrus, pear and mineral notes

Mer & Soleil Chardonnay ♦ California \$38

Oak brings strong buttered toast and vanilla flavors to this Chardonnay. It's a powerhouse, with massive orange, pineapple and apricot flavors

Muga Rosado ♦ Spain \$24

Intense fresh, strawberry, raspberry and orange peel aromas

Broadbent Vinho Verde ♦ Portugal \$23

Light and lively with refreshing spritz. Perfect for an afternoon on the patio!

Annalisa Moscato ♦ Spain \$22

Aromas of peach blossoms and citrus wrapped around a softly sweet, luscious palate filled with nectarine and apple notes
